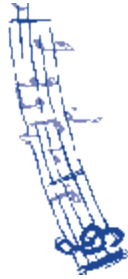

## General Information

**The Jackson Symphony Summer Music Camp** is a half-day camp open to woodwind, brass, percussion and string players. Admission is open to brass, woodwind and percussion players going into the seventh grade through those that have just graduated from high school, with at least one year of playing experience. String players must have at least 18 months of playing experience and be at least seven years old.

**The camp day** is 3 hours long. High School Concert Band students (rising 9th grade through those just graduated) and advanced string students will attend camp from 9:00 a.m. until noon. Junior High Concert Band (rising 7th and 8th graders) and intermediate/beginning string students will attend camp from 12:30 p.m. until 3:30 p.m.

**Camp tuition** covers all camp-related costs, including a camp T-shirt and a camp group photo.

**An acceptance packet** will be sent upon receipt of the registration form and tuition fee.

The packet will contain additional information.

**A Camp Concert** will be given on Friday night, June 11 at 7:00 p.m.

## Ensemble Directors

**Janet Warren** is recently retired after 38 years as a band director. She holds degrees in music education from Lincoln University and the University of Missouri with additional work at the University of Memphis. She has taught in Missouri, in the Jackson-Madison County School system and at Jackson State Community College. While teaching at North Side Junior High, her band was selected to perform at the prestigious International Band and Orchestra Clinic in Chicago. During her tenure at Jackson State, she founded the Jackson Area Community Band and served as its director for 10 years. Her bands consistently earned superior ratings at concert festival. Her last position was at Madison Academic High School in Jackson. She has served as a clinician and adjudicator in Tennessee, Arkansas, North Carolina and Mississippi and is a past president of WTSBOA.

**Betty Eubank** holds a Bachelor's degree from The University of Memphis in Music Education and Master of Music degree from The University of Wisconsin at Stevens Point. She is about to begin her 37th year as a string instructor and has been with the Memphis City Schools for 33 of those years. Her high school and middle school orchestras have earned superior ratings year after year. She has served as clinician at Quad State in Murray, KY and has taught at the Rhodes College Chamber Music Camp. She is a member of the viola section of The Jackson Symphony and is an active freelance musician in Memphis and the West Tennessee area.
